Diane Giordano is a tax partner in Marcum LLP's Melville office, where she works closely with large, multistate companies and family-owned businesses, providing tax consulting, financial statement disclosure and compliance services.

As the firm's tax training coordinator, Giordano organizes classes based on staff level throughout the year. She arranges for guest speakers and determines if department members should attend outside sessions.
